LCSO Catches Two in the Act of Burglarizing Local Business

Yesterday, just after 5:30 am, deputies on patrol were dispatched to the Dollar General store located in the 4600 block of Blountstown Highway in reference to an alarm at the building.

When they arrived; Deputy Baumann, Deputy Getz, and Deputy Puscas found 23-year-old Ruben Ruiz running from the business. Ruiz was caught after a brief foot pursuit. Ruiz also threatened to have the deputies killed by "putting hits" on them.

Deputies also found 18-year-old Hilario Gonzalez attempting to leave the area in a car.

Deputies were able to verify both Ruiz and Gonzalez were involved in the burglary by watching the store's surveillance video. Both were taken to the Leon County Detention Facility.
