LCSO Makes an Arrest in Morning Bomb Threat to Schools

Around 9 a.m. this morning, the Consolidated Dispatch Agency received a phone call advising explosive devices had been placed at three local schools (Godby, Leon, Rickards) and two local grocery stores.

In conjunction with the Tallahassee Police Department, deputies began investigating the claims. Through investigative means, law enforcement was able to locate a suspect, 67 year old Blake Hairston, at his residence.

Hairston accompanied deputies to the Sheriff's Office to speak with detectives. After speaking with detectives, Harrison was arrested and transported to the Leon County Detention Facility.

No devices were found at any of the reported locations. No bomb making materials were located in conjunction with this investigation.
