LCSO's SPIDER Unit gets Another Gun Off the Streets

Yesterday, the Leon County Sheriff's Office SPIDER Unit conducted a traffic stop at S. Meridian and Castlewood for an equipment violation and contact was made with 19-year-old, Reginald Thurman. The odor of cannabis was detected coming from inside the vehicle. Upon instructing Thurman to exit the vehicle, a pat search of his waistband revealed him to be in possession of a loaded Carl Walther .22 caliber semi-automatic pistol. A search of the vehicle was conducted and cannabis was located throughout the vehicle. Thurman was arrested and charged appropriately.
