Traffic Stop Leads to Another Firearm off the Streets

On Saturday evening, the Leon County Sheriff's Office SPIDER Unit conducted a traffic stop in the area of 2020 West Pensacola Street for an equipment violation. As contact was being made with 19-year-old, Joe Slater, he was seen throwing an object behind his seat, which was later determined to be a small silver Raven Arms .25 auto caliber firearm. A criminal history check revealed Slater to be a convicted felon, listed as a violent felony offender, and on probation for aggravated battery with a deadly weapon. Slater was transported to the Detention Facility and charged appropriately.
