LCSO Investigating Homicide on Rose Road

At approximately 8:45 p.m. on January 12, 2011, the Leon County Sheriff's Office responded to a residence in the 10,000 block of Rose Road in reference to a shooting. Upon their arrival, deputies discovered three persons with gunshot wounds, one of them, Nina Savary, 60, was dead.

Detectives from the Crime Scene and Violent Crimes Units responded to the scene and launched an investigation into the chain of events surrounding the shooting. Detectives confirmed that Nina Savary died on the scene. Nina's husband, Stanley Savary, Sr. 72, is currently being treated at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital for gunshot wounds to the neck and hand. Stanley Savary, Jr. 45, is also being treated for a gunshot wound to the chest.

Detectives believe Stanley Savary, Jr. shot Nina Savary in the head with a handgun, killing her. He then shot his father through the hand and neck, seriously injuring Stanley Savary, Sr. Jeffrey Savary, 35, attempted to subdue his brother and was able to wrestle the handgun away from him. During the struggle, Stanley Savary, Jr. was shot in the chest.

Detectives served a search warrant on the residence, processed the scene for forensic evidence and conducted interviews throughout the night. An autopsy was performed on Nina Savary this morning and the preliminary results are consistent with the detectives' initial findings from the scene.

Sheriff Larry Campbell stated, "This is a tragic situation. Once again, these events confirm that everyone involved in a violent domestic situation loses. In one night, different members of the same family have lost their life, a loved-one and their freedom."

Detectives intend to charge Stanley Savary, Jr. with Murder, Attempted Murder and Aggravated Assault as soon as he is released from the hospital.

Stanley Savary, Sr. was listed in serious condition and Stanley Savary, Jr. was listed in stable condition.
