LCSO Charges Man with Attempted Murder after Shooting Incident

On Sunday, January 15, 2012 at approximately 6:30 am, the Leon County Sheriff's Office responded to the 4500 block of High Grove Road in reference to a disturbance involving gun shots being fired. Arriving deputies contacted David Short, Holly Torres and Abigail Glass. The three told deputies that they had been at a party in Climax, Georgia on Saturday night but left and came to Tallahassee in order to get away from Holly's husband, 27 year old Jesse Torres.

Hours later, Short, Glass and Torres were awakened in Short's residence when Jesse Torres forcibly entered the residence armed with a 12 gauge shotgun. Short and Torres struggled and then Short retreated to a bedroom. Torres then fired the shotgun through the bedroom door and into the room where Short, Glass and Torres were located. Torres then struck Holly with the shotgun and fled the scene.

Jesse Torres contacted the Bainbridge Police Department after returning to Georgia and was taken into custody without any further incident. On January 18, 2012, Torres was booked into the Leon County Jail.

Holly Torres and David Short sustained minor injuries during the altercation.
