## **DEPUTIES SEEK MAN IN ATTEMPTED MURDER INVESTIGATION**

The Leon County Sheriff's Office is seeking assistance in locating a Kentucky man suspected in an attempted murder that occurred this morning.

Early this morning, deputies were called to a home in the Centerville Road area of eastern Tallahassee. There they learned William Dishman, 9-1-69, had burglarized the victim's home and beaten her with a bat. During the ordeal, the victim was able to distract Dishman and escape.

Deputies report that William Dishman is possibly driving the victim's green 2001 Nissan Sentra bearing Florida tag "H176UV". Dishman has an extensive criminal history and is considered dangerous. If you see William Dishman or the victim's 2001 Nissan Sentra, do not approach and immediately notify the Leon County Sheriff's Office at 922-3300.
