Man Arrested for the Attempted Murder of His Father

Last night at approximately 10:30PM Leon County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a camper trailer in the National Forest on Forest Road 301, in reference to a domestic altercation. During the investigation it was discovered that Daniel Hodge and his father, Bobby Hodge, had been engaged in a heated argument over the subjects of same-sex marriage and politics. During the argument Daniel Hodge grabbed a steak knife and stabbed his father twice in the upper torso, which caused his father to lose consciousness. Daniel then cut his own wrist. After regaining consciousness Bobby Hodge fled from the camper and hid in a nearby tree stand. Daniel Hodge then flagged down a passing motorist at the intersection of Forest Road 301 and 325, who called the Sheriff's Office for assistance. Daniel was taken into custody without incident and a Sheriff's K-9 unit was able to track Bobby Hodge to the tree stand where he had been hiding. Bobby Hodge was transported to Tallahassee Memorial Hospital with serious, but non-life threatening injuries. Daniel Hodge was treated for minor injures and released. Daniel Hodge was then arrested and booked into the Leon County Jail for Attempted Murder.
