## **DISHMAN FLED FROM STOLEN VEHICLE**

At 9:00 PM last night, Tallahassee Police Officer Rob Bascom spotted the stolen Nissan Sentra believed to be driven by attempted murder suspect William Dishman on South Meridian Street. As Officer Bascom attempted a traffic stop of the vehicle the driver quickly stopped and fled on foot.

Officers and K-9 Team "Jedi" and Bill Hurbult set up a perimeter and tracked the subject. LCSO Deputies joined in the perimeter; however, the subject evaded capture. The car was seized for processing for latent evidence by LCSO Crime Scene and Violent Crimes Detectives.

"With Officer Bascom stopping the stolen car, it brought critical evidence forward for this case," said Sheriff Larry Campbell.

William Dishman is still at large. The Leon County Sheriff's Office holds outstanding arrest warrants for Dishman charging him with Attempted Murder, Kidnapping to Facilitate a Felony, Grand Theft Motor Vehicle, and Felony Criminal Mischief.
