TRAFFIC STOP YIELDS CRACK COCAINE

Deputies arrest a Tallahassee man after Crack Cocaine is discovered sticking out of his shirt sleeve during a traffic stop.

On January 24, 2007, deputies stopped Brent Paris, 28, on Tipperary Drive in the Killearn Estates neighborhood for speeding. During the stop it was determined Paris had a suspended drivers license. As deputies interviewed Paris about the license suspension, they observed a clear baggie that contained suspected Crack Cocaine sticking out of his shirt sleeve. The baggie was seized from Paris and ultimately found to contain almost \$1000 worth of suspected Crack Cocaine.

Brent Paris was arrested and charged with Possession of Crack Cocaine With the Intent to Sell and Driving with a Suspended License.
