Student Arrested

Tallahassee- On January 30th, a school resource deputy arrested a student for possession of a controlled substance with intent to sell within 1000 feet of a school.

Deputy Paul Emmons received information from school officials at Leon High School that a student was in possession of two prescription bottles that did not belong to him. The administrator added that the student was originally observed passing something to another student which raised their suspicion and further investigation.

The student, Larry Nelson Campbell (12/11/90, 11th Grade) was arrested on the following charges:

- 1) Possession of a Controlled Substances (Oxycodone) With intent to sell within 1,000 feet of a school
- 2) Possession of Controlled Substances (Propoxyphene generic for Darvocet) With intent to sell within 1,000 feet of a school.
