Media Advisory: Death of George E. Clinton

On Monday February 1, 2010, at approximately 12:30pm, Leon County Sheriff's Deputies were called to Plantation at Pine Lake Apartments located at 1833 Halstead Boulevard to conduct an investigation into the discovery of a dead body. A maintenance worker checking on the welfare of a resident discovered the deceased inside apartment 807 and called the Sheriff's Office. Detectives responded to the apartment and conducted a death investigation. It appeared the deceased had been dead for several days. No signs of foul play were found during the investigation and Detectives identified the deceased as George E. Clinton (DOB: 11/22/1959). The Medical Examiner's Office was notified of the on-scene investigative findings and will conduct a visual inspection of the deceased. Once the Medical Examiner's Office has completed the visual inspection, the body will be released to family members for burial.

The Leon County Sheriff's Office investigation will be concluded once the Medical Examiner has released the body to family members. It should be noted that the Leon County Sheriff's Office is not aware of the burial plans or arrangements for Clinton, and will be referring inquires of this nature to the family of the deceased.
