Update: Detectives Request Assistance from Jefferson County Residents

As the investigation into the disappearance of Danielle Brown continues, Leon County Sheriff's Detectives have developed investigative information which indicates that Elijah James may have been in Jefferson County, Florida during the early morning hours of Saturday February 6, 2010. Detectives believe that James may have been in the area of the Wacissa and Waukeenah communities, in Jefferson County, between the hours of 12:30a.m. and 5:00a.m. on Saturday February 6, 2010. Detectives have also developed information that James may have been in several areas of Jefferson County on Sunday February 7, 2010, between the hours of 8:00a.m. and 8p.m. James may have been driving Danielle's 1994 Silver Buick.
