### Detectives Investigating Kidnapping and Robbery

At approximately 6:30 a.m. on February 21, 2011, an employee of Tallahassee Leon Federal Credit Union was approached by an unknown black male with a gun outside of his residence in the 6200 block of Huckleberry Lane. One suspect entered the residence and bound two additional victims with duct tape while another suspect made the credit union employee drive to the Tallahassee Leon Federal Credit Union located at 1867 Capital Circle North East.

Once they entered the credit union, the victim was ordered to open the vault, but was unable to. The victim ultimately removed money from his personal account by using the ATM. The suspect and the victim then returned to the residence. The suspects took an undisclosed amount of cash and the victim's car, but abandoned it a short distance from the residence. No one was injured during this incident.

Suspect #1 is described as a Black Male, 6'0", and 200 lbs, wearing a black "Dickies" style shirt, black mask and gloves. **(The photo below is from the credit union's surveillance system)**

Suspect #2 is described as a black male 6'0" – 6'2", 320 pounds, wearing all black clothing, tan work boots and a camouflage mask.
