Detectives Seek Identity of Subject

On Tuesday, February 16, 2010, a citizen reported that funds had been withdrawn from his bank account without his knowledge. Bank records indicated the withdrawals were made using his ATM card, but the victim was still in possession of his ATM card and had not withdrawn the funds. An investigation by Financial Crimes Detectives has revealed that on Monday, February 1, 2010, the victim used a drive-up ATM at Florida Commerce Credit Union located at 1460 Capital Circle Northwest. Once the victim had completed his transaction he pulled away from the ATM without closing out his account screen. The next subject pulled up to the ATM at 8:28 a.m., found the victim's account still accessible and removed funds from the victim's account.

Detectives remind citizens that when using an ATM, after your transaction is finished, be sure you have your ATM card, your transaction receipt and your account information is no longer accessible.

Security Video was obtained by Detectives which shows the unknown subject who removed the funds from the victim's account. Anyone who recognizes the subject pictured is asked to call the Leon County Sheriff's Office at (850) 922-3300 or Crime Stoppers at (850)574-TIPS.
