### Update: Conor McBride Charged with Attempted Murder

Today at approximately 2:15p.m., Conor McBride entered the Tallahassee Police Department lobby and advised he had killed his fiancée at 124 Mill Branch Road. When Deputies arrived at the residence they located Ann M. Grosmaire (19yoa). Grosmaire was alive, but unresponsive, and was transported to Tallahassee Memorial Hospital for treatment of a life-threatening gunshot wound. McBride was taken into custody and an investigation by Leon County Sheriff's Office Violent Crime Detectives revealed the following.

McBride and Grosmaire were at his parent's residence located at 124 Mill Branch Road, where it is believed they engaged in a verbal argument. During the argument McBride armed himself with a shotgun, which was in the home, and shot Grosmaire in the head. McBride believed that Grosmaire was dead and drove himself to the Tallahassee Police Department to report this crime. Once Deputies arrived they located Grosmaire in a bedroom with a gunshot wound to the head. The shotgun believed to have been used by McBride was found in the residence. McBride and Grosmaire were the only occupants of the residence when this crime occurred.

McBride is charged with Attempted Murder and has been booked into the Leon County Jail. Grosmaire remains in critical condition.
