Abduction Attempt

Tallahassee- A Tallahassee woman was the reported victim of an attempted abduction last night on Tallahassee's Southside.

Shortly before 10:00 PM, a K-9 team training in the area of the Flea Market, Capital Circle Southeast responded to a woman screaming. Deputies located the victim and she reported that a man attempted to abduct her by force. The victim said a white male driving a light colored pickup with magnetic signs drove past her a couple of times and then pulled over and solicited her. When she refused, the man exited the truck, grabbed her from behind and attempted to pull her to the truck. The victim said this is when she began to scream which brought attention to the situation causing the man to release her and flee.

The victim described the subject as a white male, thirty-five years of age, 5'11" tall weighing 200 pounds. He has blond hair and a ruddy complexion. The victim described the subject's truck as a 1994 to 1998 Ford Ranger extended cab, gold or silver in color with magnetic signs on the doors.
