### One Dead and Five Shot at Lake Bradford McDonalds\Circle K

This morning at approximately 4:20am, Leon County Sheriff's Deputy Adam Wilkinson was on patrol in the area of Airport Drive and Epps Street when he heard the sound of gun shots in the area of Lake Bradford Road. As Deputy Wilkinson checked the area he observed a large panicked crowd of approximately 150 people fleeing the parking lot of the McDonalds\Circle K located at 811 Lake Bradford. Deputy Wilkinson discovered that one male victim had been shot and was dead in the front parking lot and that another male had been wounded by a gun shot. Additional Deputies and Officers with the Tallahassee Police Department quickly responded to the scene and immediately began an investigation.

Several witnesses were located and are being interviewed at the Leon County Sheriff's Office. As the investigation at the McDonalds\Circle K was underway three additional subjects arrived at the Tallahassee Memorial Hospital Emergency Room with non-life threatening gun shot wounds as a result of this incident. A short time later one addition subject arrived at Capital Regional Medical Center also with non-life threatening gun shot wounds as a result of this incident.

The deceased has been identified as Curtis Brown, 26yoa. The injured subjects are a 33yoa male, 15yoa male, 18yoa male, 21yoa male and a 22yoa male. The injured are all expected to recover from their gun shot wounds.

Crime Scene Detectives are currently processing the crime scene for evidence related to this homicide and Violent Crime Detectives are interviewing witnesses and reviewing store surveillance tape. At this time there is no known motive or suspect description. As suspect information is developed it will be released to the public.

Sheriff Larry Campbell said "this senseless killing and gun violence will not be tolerated in our community. The Leon County Sheriff's Office has committed its full resources to identify and bring to justice the person, or persons, responsible for this morning's carnage. I thank our partners at the Tallahassee Police Department for their assistance and ask anybody that witnessed this barbaric act of violence and cowardice to contact Violent Crimes Detectives at (850) 922-3300 or Crime Stoppers at (850) 574-8477.
