LCSO Investigating Early Morning Robberies

Early this morning at approximately 5:00a.m., Leon County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the Circle K Store, located at 4122 North Monroe Street, in reference to the report of a robbery. The store clerk advised a male subject entered the store, implied he was armed and demanded money. The clerk complied and the suspect stole an undisclosed amount of cash and lottery tickets. The suspect was last seen running south away from the store. The suspect is described as a white male, 6'0", 150lbs, wearing a navy blue hoodie and a blue bandana covering his face. A K-9 unit responded to the scene and tracked the suspect south away from the store. During the track the K-9 unit located a firearm and evidence that the suspect had fled the area in an unknown vehicle.

Then at approximately 5:20a.m., Deputies responded to the Express Lane, located at 7999 Blountstown Highway, in reference to an armed robbery. The store clerk reported two male subjects entered the store and demanded cash. One of the suspects was armed with a silver handgun. The clerk complied and the suspects stole an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspects were last seen running east away from the store.

Suspect #1 is described as a black male, 5'7"-5'9", 200lb, wearing a black short sleeve shirt, red and black shoes, black shorts, black ski mask, and armed with a silver semi-auto handgun.

Suspect #2 is described as a black male, 5'6"-5'8", 180lbs, wearing blue jeans, dark colored shoes, black ski mask, and a white jacket with blue plaid hood which was pulled over his head.
