Store Clerk Threatened by Man Armed with Knife

Last night at approximately 10:55pm, Leon County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the Shell Gas Station at 6625 Mahan Drive in reference to a disturbance. The clerk reported that a white male wearing a white hat, white sleeveless shirt, and blue jeans entered the gas station, brandished a knife and threatened to kill him. The clerk responded by arming himself with a firearm and ordered the suspect to leave the store. The suspect quickly complied and the clerk called the Sheriff's Office. According to a witness the suspect was last seen running westbound away from the store.

As Deputy Dan Roufa arrived in the area he observed the suspect walking in the parking lot of the Best Western located approximately 200 yards from the Shell station. The suspect, Glen Cantrell, was taken into custody without incident. The clerk identified Cantrell as the suspect that threatened him with a knife. At the time Cantrell was taken into custody he was not armed. Deputy Morgan Wysocki conducted an evidence search with his K-9 partner "Moose" and the knife was located in some bushes approximately 15 to 20 yards from where Cantrell was arrested. The clerk verified the knife found by "Moose" was the same knife used by the suspect during this aggravated assault.
