Robbery

State Road 20- A Leon County man was robbed at gunpoint as he left a package store in western Leon County.

Shortly after 9:00 PM last night, the victim left Talquin's Liquor, 7115 Blountstown Highway. He reported that as he walked to his car, two subjects approached him and demanded his property. The victim told deputies he complied and after receiving an undisclosed amount of personal property, the subjects fled the area.

Deputies and a K-9 Team responded and tracked the subjects to the rear of the Sand Stone Ranch Neighborhood where the track was lost.

The victim described the suspects as black males in their teens. The first subject is 5'10 tall with a slim build. He was last seen wearing dark pants and a medium colored shirt. He was also armed with a handgun. The second subject was described as 5'08" tall weighing 150 pounds with shoulder length dreadlocks. He was last seen wearing dark pants and a white t-shirt.

It is believed the subjects might have been loitering around the store prior to the robbery. Anyone with information is asked to call the Robbery Task Force at 891-4200 or Crime Stoppers at 574-TIPS.
