Woman Charged with the Murder of Anderson Nelson

On Tuesday June 10, 2008, deputies were called to 983 Towhee Road by the brother of 70 year old Anderson Nelson. Mr. Nelson was found dead in the living room laying face down on the floor. His face had several lacerations as if he had suffered trauma to his head. The brother also reported the victim's vehicle, a 1988 Cadillac, was missing. Another family member reported she had seen three females driving the vehicle earlier in the day, one of which was known to her. This information about the vehicle led investigators to Calvin Hills, who was arrested for the murder of Nelson.

During the investigation Hills was arrested and implicated three females, Jamerica Jackson, Angela Bailey and Brenda Ward in the murder of Nelson. As detectives continued to investigate Hills claims, Angela Bailey became a suspect in the murder of Nelson and in another robbery. Today Bailey was arrested for Nelson's murder and in connection with another robbery.

Detectives have determined that a few weeks ago Calvin Hills and Angela Bailey went to another victim's residence to borrow money from him to buy crack cocaine. When the victim refused Hills told him he had a gun, then struck and choked him until the victim gave Hills \$60.00. Hills and Bailey used the money from the robbery to buy crack cocaine.

Then on Sunday June 8, 2008, Bailey stated she and Hills went to Anderson Nelson's residence to borrow money from him to buy crack cocaine. According to Bailey, she followed Hills into Nelsons residence and watched as Nelson was beaten by Hills. After Hills beat Nelson they took his wallet and vehicle, leaving the residence to buy crack cocaine. According to Bailey, Jackson and Ward where not part of the robbery and murder of Nelson. Detectives have interviewed Jackson and Ward and have eliminated them as suspects in this investigation.

Sheriff Larry Campbell said "As I said at the beginning of this investigation, any person who was part of, or benefited from, this heinous crime would be held accountable. Calvin Hills terrorized southern Leon County and Angela Bailey was with him every step of the way, enjoying all the ill gotten gains. Now it is time for her to answer for her crimes. While I know these arrests will not take away the pain from Mr. Nelson's family, I do hope it brings them some comfort to know the people responsible for his death are off the street and will face justice."
