Leon County Sheriff's Office Seeks Assistance in Locating Missing Women

The Leon County Sheriff's Office is seeking the public's assistance in locating Sylvania M. Henderson. Henderson was last seen leaving her residence at 3216 Jim Lee Road on Monday, May 19th 2008. She has not been in contact with family or friends since this time. Henderson left the residence with two males in a Black Nissan Altima or similar vehicle. One of the males is known only as "Jamar" and is described as a black male, 5'7", dark complexion with short dreadlock hair.

According to family and friends, Henderson has never gone this long of time without making contact. While there is no evidence of foul play, detectives are concerned for Henderson's safety and welfare, as her consistent pattern of staying in contact with family and friends has been broken. Henderson's status is listed as Missing and Endangered.
