Suspicious Death Investigated

Tallahassee- The Leon County Sheriff's Office is investigating a suspicious death involving a man in his early twenties.

At about 8:00 AM deputies were called to the Tallahassee Memorial Hospital Emergency Room to investigate the death. Deputies learned that a twenty three year old male subject was brought in by a subject shortly before 8:00 AM and pronounced dead upon arrival.

The subject that transported the deceased to the hospital told detectives she discovered the man in a car that was parked in her driveway in the 100 Block of Jennings Street about 7:30 AM this morning. She reported the subject was unresponsive so she drove him to the hospital.

According to Sgt. Chris Chase, LCSO Spokesman "the deceased and the subject are known to one another". Chase added "due to the circumstances of the case we are treating this as a criminal investigation until we can pinpoint a cause of death".

The name of the deceased is not being released pending the positive identification and subsequent notification of the next of kin.

An autopsy is scheduled for later in the day.
