Leon County Sheriff's Detectives Seek Assistance in Car Wash Burglaries

On Sunday June 22, 2008, at approximately 4:34 a.m. an unknown suspect used a crow bar to break into the cash machine at the Super Splash Car Wash, located at 3781 North Monroe Street. The suspect is described as a white male, 5'7" to 5'9", 150 pounds, blue jeans, white t-shirt with writing on the front, white tennis shoes, brown medium length hair and brown mustache. The suspect may have been riding a bicycle.

The suspect appeared to be wearing rubber gloves and used a crowbar and screwdriver to gain access to the cash machine. The suspect caused approximately \$5000.00 in damage to the machine and stole an undetermined amount of money.

This same business was the victim of a theft from a coin operated vacuum cleaner on Thursday June 18, 2008. In that incident an unknown suspect, driving a white truck pried open the coin container and stole an undetermined amount of quarters.

Included in this release are security camera photographs of the suspects captured during these crimes.
