## **Family Dollar Store Robbed**

Last night, Wednesday June 25, 2008, at approximately 8:00 p.m., two males robbed the Family Dollar Store located at 5267 Capital Circle Southwest. As the store clerks closed for the night, they were confronted by two black males wearing masks and armed with handguns. The suspects stole an undetermined amount of money from the store and from one of the clerks. Before fleeing the store, the suspects bound the wrist of the clerks with tape and forced them to lie down on the office floor.

The suspects were seen leaving the store running westbound from the store. A K-9 unit responded and tracked the suspects to the power lines, just west of the store, where fresh tire tracks were located.

Suspect #1 is described as a black male, 6'0", slender build, wearing a black hat, grey long sleeve shirt, dark pants and black bandana covering his face.

Suspect #2 is described as black male, 5'8", stocky build, wearing a dark long sleeve shirt, dark pants and a ski mask covering his face.
