Update: Arrest Made In Riverfront Saloon Shooting

On Saturday June 27, 2009, at approximately 2:19AM, Leon County Sheriff's Deputies where called to the Riverfront Saloon located at 9330 West Tennessee Street in reference to a physical altercation in progress and shots fired. When Deputies arrived they discovered 22yoa, Shawn Jones, in the parking lot who had been shot once in the chest. The investigation revealed that as the Riverfront closed a large crowd gathered in the parking lot, and several fights occurred. During one of the fights, Jones observed several people fighting with a friend of his, at which point he engaged in a physical altercation and was subsequently shot in the chest. As Deputies arrived on scene, witnesses provided a possible suspect vehicle, which was described as a tan Chevrolet SUV. This vehicle was seen fleeing the parking lot of the Riverfront Saloon moments after the shooting. This information was broadcasted to responding Deputies.

At approximately 2:29AM, Deputy Michael Crego observed a gold Chevrolet Tahoe traveling East on Tennessee Street. A traffic stop of the vehicle was conducted on Tennessee Street near Appleyard Drive. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Khalif Wilson. Wilson denied any involvement in the shooting; however, Deputies observed Wilson's clothing was stained with blood and discovered that Wilson had been in a fight at the Riverfront. Wilson was interviewed and his vehicle seized as evidence. Later during processing of Wilson's vehicle a .45 handgun was found. This is the same caliber of spent bullet casings which were found at the scene of the shooting.

After an intensive investigation Detectives have placed Wilson at the scene when Jones was shot, and the victim has identified Wilson as the person who shot him during the fight. An arrest warrant was obtained for Wilson and he was arrested last night, without incident, by the Tallahassee Police Department at his home located at 820 West Carolina Street #1. Wilson has been booked into the Leon County Jail with no bond and is charged with Attempted First Degree Murder. Jones who had been listed in critical condition is expected to fully recover from his injuries.
