Update: Man Arrested for Car Wash Burglary

On Sunday June 22, 2008, at approximately 4:34 a.m. an unknown suspect used a crow bar to break into the cash machine at the Super Splash Car Wash, located at 3781 North Monroe Street. The suspect caused approximately \$5000.00 in damage to the machine and stole an undetermined amount of money. A security camera captured the suspect committing this burglary.

On Sunday July 6, 2008, the Tallahassee Police Department responded to a burglary alarm at the Super Lube on the corner of Mahan Drive and Capital Circle, and found Alex Matthews breaking into the business. Matthews was arrested by TPD and charged with damaged property of \$1000 or more, possession of burglary tools, and possession of narcotic equipment.

Today, Monday July 7, 2008, Leon County Sheriff's Detective John Rudd interviewed Matthews who admitted to the June 22, 2008 burglary at the Super Splash Car Wash. Matthews is charged with felony criminal mischief, burglary and theft.
