Man Wanted for Early Morning Attack

Early this morning at approximately 1:00AM, Leon County Sheriff's Deputy Joe LeSerra responded to a residence in the 1900 Block of Talpeco Road in reference to a 28yoa male who had been stabbed. The victim reported while he was sitting on the front porch of his residence, an unknown male emerged from a wooded area adjacent to his home and demanded to be let in the residence. The victim refused and struggled with the unknown suspect to keep him out of his home, which was occupied by the victim's wife who was sleeping. During the altercation the victim was stabbed and cut with an edged weapon on his left shoulder, arm and leg. The suspect then fled the area and the victim was able to call the Sheriff's Office. The victim was transported to Tallahassee Memorial Hospital, treated for several lacerations and released.

The victim advised Violent Crimes Detectives the suspect was a white male, 6'3" to 6'4", thin build in his 30's to 40's with dirty brown hair. Deputy LeSerra recognized this description as a subject known to him as Raymond B. Harrell. Harrell is a homeless person who is known to frequent the area of this attack. Earlier in the evening at approximately 9:00PM, Deputy LeSerra observed Harrell riding a red bicycle in the area of the 3200 block of North Monroe.

A photographic line-up containing Harrell's picture was conducted with the victim, who advised Harrell was the suspect who attacked him and attempted to enter his residence. Harrell is wanted for Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon and Burglary of a Dwelling while Armed.
