Women Arrested for 2nd Degree Murder

On Sunday, February 10, 2008, at 6:51p.m. the Leon County Sheriff's Office received a phone call from 913 Casey Drive in reference to a domestic disturbance, in which a person had been stabbed. Responding deputies discovered that a physical altercation took place between Christopher Girdner, 22 yoa, and Angela Prim. During the altercation Girdner received stab wounds to his throat and back, which ultimately resulted in his death at the hospital early the following Monday morning. Prim received minor injuries as a result of this altercation. The incident remained under investigation until May 29, 2008, when Detectives obtained a warrant for Prim's arrest for 2nd Degree Murder.

While this incident remained under investigation, family members of Prim assisted the Leon County Sheriff's Office in locating and arranging for her voluntary return to Tallahassee. On Saturday, July 12, 2008, Prim returned to Tallahassee, via a flight from New York into Tallahassee Regional Airport. Upon departing her flight, a family member advised a Tallahassee Airport Police Officer of her arrival and the arrest warrant. Prim was taken into custody without incident and booked into the Leon County Jail.

During this investigation, Detectives discovered inconsistencies in Prim's statements from the night of the altercation compared to a subsequent interview on February 21, 2008. The investigation was reviewed by the State Attorneys Office, who approved the probable cause and the arrest warrant was signed by Judge Augustus Aikens.
