Leon County Sheriff's Deputies Arrest Two Suspects for Burglary of Buck Lake Elementary

Early this morning at approximately 2:00AM Leon County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a burglary alarm at Buck Lake Elementary School (1600 Pedrick Road). Once on scene, Lieutenant Leonard Reeves and Deputy Anthony Geraldi located two subjects inside Building 100. Deputy Geraldi was familiar with the subjects and identified them as Roger Kiser and William Coulter Jr. As Kiser and Coulter exited the building they were confronted by Lt. Reeves and Deputy Geraldi. Kiser was quickly taken into custody, but Coulter fled the area. A short time later Coulter was located at his residence and arrested without incident.

During this burglary, Kiser and Coulter first broke into the school maintenance room. After finding nothing of interest they broke into Building 100. During the burglary Kiser and Coulter attempted to steal Polaroid film, hand sanitizer, handcuffs, paperclips and matches.

During the investigation Detective Ted Phillips questioned Kiser in reference to another burglary that occurred at the school during the first week of July, 2008. During this burglary the suspects set off fire extinguishers inside the school and stole media equipment and several computer hard drives. Kiser admitted that he and Coulter committed this burglary.

Kiser was booked into the Leon County Jail, and Coulter was booked into the Juvenile Assessment Center.
