Convenience Store Robbery

Woodville- Deputies are investigating a Southern Leon County convenience store robbery.

Just before 3:00 AM this morning Leon County Sheriff's deputies were called to the Kangaroo/Inland Convenience Store at 9160 Woodville Highway to a reported robbery. The victim told deputies a subject armed with a handgun approached him while he was outside and forced him back into the store. Once inside, the subject demanded money. After receiving an undisclosed amount of money the suspect fled on foot.

A K-9 Team responded and tracked the subject to the area of the Old Woodville Highway. Deputies found indications that the subject fled the area in a vehicle.

The victim described the subject as a black male, slim build wearing all black with sunglasses.
