Deputy Interrupts Burglars Getaway

Southern Leon County- A Leon County Sheriff's deputy disrupted the getaway of a suspected commercial burglar in the early hours this morning.

At approximately 2:00 AM, Deputy Camilla Schaefer reported she passed a subject walking on Capital Circle Southwest at Ruthenia Road. As she turned around to contact the subject, he dropped a bag containing an undisclosed amount of money and other property and fled on foot. Soon thereafter Deputy Schaefer discovered the Quick Stop convenience store at 4784 Capital Circle SW had been burglarized.

After reviewing surveillance video from the store, deputies were able to confirm the subject that fled from Deputy Schaefer was in fact the burglar.
