Man Arrested for Scrap Metal Thefts

On July 19, 2011 the Leon County Sheriff's Office received information about a man driving on Tiny Leaf Road acting suspicious. A short time later, an air conditioner was reported stolen from the 2500 block of Tiny Leaf Road. Deputies canvassing the area located a witness who reported a man in a black truck actually stopped to tell him that he was going to be cleaning up the area where the air conditioner was stolen.

On August 2, 2011, LCSO received another call from the witness stating that the same man in the same truck was back in the area again and was possibly committing additional thefts. Deputies made contact with 39 year old Nathaniel Harris in a black Chevrolet truck. Harris was still in the area. Today, deputies recovered several metal items from Harris' truck and also learned that the stolen air conditioner from the July 19 report had been sold for scrap metal at a local second hand metals dealer.
