Man Stabbed During Early Morning Disturbance

At approximately 6:00 a.m. on August 05, 2011 the Leon County Sheriff's Office received information about a disturbance in the 1700 block of Oak Ridge East. When deputies arrived, they discovered 38 year old Miguel Rivera had been stabbed with a large kitchen knife. Rivera and other witnesses told deputies and violent crime detectives that Rivera woke 22 year old Robert P. Udell up to talk to him.

Detectives say that an argument started and the two men agreed to walk outside the residence. At some point during the argument, Rivera decided to turn and walk away. As Rivera was walking away, Udell produced a large kitchen knife which was laying close by, walked up behind Rivera and stabbed him.

Rivera was transported to Tallahassee Memorial Hospital with the knife still impaled in his upper chest/shoulder area. Udell fled the scene and has not been located at this time. Udell currently has two outstanding warrants for his arrest and detectives are in the process of obtaining warrants in connection with this investigation.
