Update: Man Arrested for Selling Stolen Cars for Scrap Metal

On Tuesday August 5, 2008, Leon County Sheriff's Detectives arrested David Clayton who had been stealing cars by having them towed to Jack's Auto Recycling, located at 4413 Entrepot Blvd. and then crushed for scrap metal. As this investigation continued Leon County Sheriff's Detectives Damon Sullivan and Shannon Black discovered that on Monday July 28, 2008, Clayton stole at least twelve (12) other vehicles from the Florida State University impound and storage lot located on Plant Street. As in the other known cases, Clayton contacted Mauldin's Automotive Towing authorizing them to tow the vehicles to Jack's Auto Recycling. Jack's Auto Recycling then crushed the vehicles and paid Clayton approximately \$300.00 per vehicle. The investigation continues and more charges will be filed against Clayton in the near future.
