### Tip-A-Cop Event Raises Five Thousand Dollars for Special Olympics

On August 25, 2011 the Leon County Sheriff's Office participated in the annual Tip-A-Cop event at Longhorn Steakhouse to benefit Special Olympics Florida. During the event, LCSO employees and volunteers waited tables and assisted the Longhorn Steakhouse staff with serving 570 meals between 11:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. Tipsters donated over **\$5,000.00** to support this worthy cause.

Sheriff Larry Campbell said, "We really appreciate the fine folks at Longhorn Steakhouse for once again helping us make this event a huge success. I'm also glad our law enforcement family and this community graciously donated their time, hard work and money in support of the Special Olympics."
