Detectives Arrest Two in Kangaroo Express Robbery

On Friday, September 24, 2010 the Leon County Sheriff's Office responded to the Kangaroo Express at 9160 Woodville Highway in reference to a robbery. The victim told deputies that two subjects armed with an ax handle entered the store, threatened the clerk and demanded money from the register.

On September 29, 2010, detectives received information from a concerned citizen that indicated Casey B. Martina, 18, was possibly responsible for the robbery. Violent Crimes detectives conducted interviews and compared forensic evidence. While reviewing surveillance videos, detectives observed an identifying mark on one of the subjects during the robbery. They were later able to confirm the mark during an interview with Robert Tully, a juvenile. Additional interviews have confirmed Martina and Tully were responsible for the robbery. Martina was taken to the Leon County Jail and Tully was taken to the Juvenile Assessment Center. This investigation is continuing and additional charges are likely.

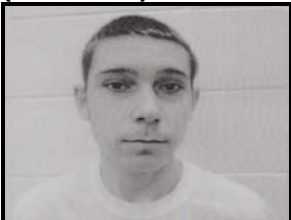
