Update: Farmers and Merchants Bank Robbed Get-Away Driver Arrested and Bank Robber Identified and Wanted

Yesterday afternoon, at approximately 4:00PM, Leon County Sheriff's Deputies responded to Farmers and Merchants Bank located at 3490 North Monroe Street, in reference to a robbery. According to the teller, a black male entered the bank, stated he was armed and ordered the teller to fill a bag with cash. After receiving an undisclosed amount of cash the subject fled the bank in a newer model black Ford Ranger truck, which was being driven by another subject. Information at the time of robbery, indicated the get-away truck may have been bearing a Florida Tag C74408. There was no record for this tag.

Last night, Deputy David Teems recalled a similar truck he had observed in the area of Clara Kee Blvd. After a search of the area, Deputy Teems located a black Ford Ranger with Florida Tag C744DH parked at residence in the 4100 Block of Heniard Blvd. Violent Crimes Detectives responded to the residence and made contact with Lynnette Manspeaker. During an interview with Manspeaker, she admitted she was the driver of the get-away vehicle. According to Manspeaker, she picked up Dexter Tyrone Johnson from a residence in the 5000 block of Pryor Court and drove him to the Farmers and Merchants Bank located at 3490 North Monroe Street. Manspeaker stated she had suspicions that Johnson had robbed the bank, due to her seeing money in a plastic bag when he came out of the bank. Manspeaker said she parked behind the bank and waited for Johnson to exit. As Johnson exited the bank he was walking quicker than when he went in, and he motioned for her to pick him up. Manspeaker stated she then drove Johnson back to the residence she picked him up from and he gave her \$10 for gas. During the interview Manspeaker stated several times she did not have any money, but a search after her arrest revealed she was in possession of \$92.96.

Violent Crimes Detectives conducted a search warrant at the address where Manspeaker stated she picked up Johnson. Johnson had been at the residence earlier, but was not there at the time of the search.
