Four Arrested for Strong Arm Robbery in Publix Parking Lot

Last night, at approximately 9:30PM, Leon County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the Publix located at 5810 North Monroe Street, in reference to a robbery. According to the victim she had just exited the Publix and was putting her groceries in her vehicle when she was attacked by a black female. The victim was thrown to the ground and after a brief struggle, the suspect stole the victims purse and fled to a waiting vehicle occupied by three black males. Two citizens observed the attack and were able to tackle the female suspect. The three waiting suspects attacked the two citizens and after a struggle, all four suspects fled the area. A passerby observed the robbery and followed the suspects to Tower Road and advised Sgt. Bobby Green of their location.

Sgt. Green located the vehicle with the suspects on Tower Road and took them into custody without incident. The victim's credit cards were located in the vehicle and all four suspects were positively identified by the victim and witnesses.

Takelia Anderson DOB: 10/15/1987 was identified as the person that attacked the victim and stole the purse. Anderson was arrested for Strong Arm Robbery. Marcus Butler DOB: 06/29/1989, Travoris Bunion DOB: 09/14/1990 and Antwan Bolware DOB: 04/25/1994 were all identified as the suspects who fought with the assisting citizens and helped Anderson flee the area. They charged with Felony Principal in the First Degree and Battery.

Anderson and Butler are adults and were booked into the Leon County Jail. Bunion and Bolware are juveniles and were booked into the Juvenile Assessment Center.

Sheriff Larry Campbell said "This is a great example of law abiding citizens helping law enforcement stop crime in our community. I applaud and thank the citizens that came to the aid of the victim and followed the suspects. Without their assistance these dangerous criminals may not have been caught."
