Tallahassee State Bank Robbery

Tallahassee- The Leon County Sheriff's Office responded to the Tallahassee State Bank reference an early morning robbery.

At approximately 9:45 AM this morning a subject entered the Tallahassee State Bank located at 3400 Thomasville Road and approached the teller line. The subject presented the teller a bank deposit bag which contained a note demanding money. The teller complied with the subject's demand. The subject then fled the bank on a black bicycle with an undisclosed amount of money.

As the subject fled the bank parking lot, the die packet exploded in the deposit bag. The subject was last seen riding away from the Killearn Shopping Center towards Halstead Blvd.

Sgt. Gary Bussell, RTF Supervisor said "the subject should have red die exposure on his clothing or person from the exploding die pack".

Tallahassee Police officers and deputies searched the area with a K-9 team and located the subject's bicycle abandoned near Halligan's Pool Hall on Village Square Blvd. Other personal property of the subject was also recovered from the immediate area of the bank.

Witnesses described the subject as a white male, possibly in his 30's with a medium build. He has black hair, possibly a wig and pale complexion. He was last seen wearing blue slippers with white socks, knee length shorts, a light colored t-shirt with a design on the front, and a white ball cap.

Sgt. Chris Chase said "we are hoping someone saw this individual before or after he committed the robbery. If you witnessed anything or have any information as insignificant as it may seem to you, we urge you to call Crime Stoppers at 574-TIPS or the Robbery Task Force at 891-4200".

There were no injuries in the robbery and a weapon was implied but not seen.
