Sun Trust Bank Robbery

Northern Leon County- The Leon County Sheriff's Office responded to the Sun Trust Bank reference an early afternoon robbery.

At approximately 1:49 PM this afternoon a subject entered the Sun Trust Bank located at 6779 Thomasville Road and approached the teller line. The subject implied he was armed and demanded money from a teller. The teller complied with the subject's demand. The subject then fled the bank on foot in a westerly direction with an undisclosed amount of money.

Witnesses place the subject possibly getting into a small size black pickup truck and driving north on US 319.

Deputies joined by the Sheriff's Aviation Unit searched the area but did not locate the subject.

Witnesses described the subject as a black male, 5'08" to 5'11" tall, with an average build He has black hair, brown eyes and was last seen wearing a dark blue or black polo type or button down shirt and a dark leather ball cap.

Sgt. Chris Chase said "we are hoping someone saw this individual before or after he committed the robbery. If you witnessed anything or have any information, as insignificant as it may seem to you, we urge you to call Crime Stoppers at 574-TIPS or the Robbery Task Force at 891-4200".

There were no injuries in the robbery and a weapon was not seen.
