Leon County Sheriff's Office 9/11 Flag Ceremony

In memory of those who died as a result of the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001, and in observance of Patriot Day, Governor Crist, in accordance with the Presidential Proclamation issued on September 8, 2008, by President George W. Bush, has asked that all state and local governments join him in remembrance of the victims who died and honor the heroic men and women who risked and sacrificed their lives so others might survive, by flying their United States and State flags at half-staff.

On Thursday morning, September 11, 2008 at 8:40AM, Sheriff Larry Campbell has ordered the United States of America flag located in front of the Leon County Sheriff's Office to be lowered to half staff by the Sheriff's Office Honor Guard. The Rickards High School marching band will provide two student trumpet musicians for playing of the National Anthem and Taps. Following the flag ceremony at 8:46AM a moment of silent reflection and prayer will be observed to honor all those who died as a result of the terrorist attack on our nation. The public is invited to observe this ceremony in front of the Leon County Sheriff's Office main office located at 2825 Municipal Way.
