Arrests in Meth Lab Case

Western Leon County- the three individuals detained yesterday in connection with the discovery of a suspected Methamphetamine Laboratory have been charged with Production of Methamphetamine and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

Yesterday Leon County Sheriff's Detectives and Special Agents from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement served a search warrant at 130-A Whispering Pines Drive after observing the components of a suspected meth lab. During the search precursor ingredients and all the necessary equipment to produce was discovered. As the Capital Regional Meth Lab Response Team dismantled the suspected lab, they located a small amount of methamphetamine finish product.

The three individuals, Jeffery Wolfgang 31, John L. Miller 30, and Kelly L. Granger 21 were taken from the scene to the Sheriff's Office for interviews. During the interviews all three admitted to participating in the production of methamphetamine at the residence. They were booked into the Leon County Jail charged with the above listed charges. John L Miller was also charged with Possession of Methamphetamine.

"Methamphetamine is a very destructive drug. It destroys the user, their family and the community" said Sgt. James McQuaig, LCSO Vice Unit.

Special Agent Dave Wilson FDLE added "anyone that has information about a suspected meth lab is asked to call your local law enforcement agency".
