A Run From the Law Ended in Jail

Southside Tallahassee- Thursday afternoon Leon County Sheriff's Vice Detectives attempted to stop a car that ran a stop sign on the Crawfordville Highway. The car fled from deputies and reportedly drove recklessly in heavy traffic showing no regard for other motorists.

According to detective's reports, the vehicle drove "off road" through a field, across a barrier, and through several small neighborhood streets until the driver abandoned it and fled on foot. During the trek through the field, detectives witnessed the driver throw multiple baggies out of the window.

After a brief foot pursuit, including the driver removing and discarding his shirt, he was taken into custody. During a search incident to the arrest a small baggie of suspected marijuana was seized from the driver's pocket.

Detective searched the field where the driver was seen throwing the baggies from the car. Several baggies of powder and Crack Cocaine were recovered. The driver, identified as Lindsey Dugan, was taken to jail without further incident.

Dugan was charged with Fleeing and Eluding Law Enforcement, Possession of Crack Cocaine With Intent to Sell, Possession of Cocaine With Intent to Sell, and Possession of Cannabis.

The street value of the suspected drugs is an estimated \$1,200.
