Update: Wanted Sex Offender Arrested

Last night a concerned citizen who was made aware of Timothy Bivins wanted status by the media contacted the Leon County Sheriff's Office with information of his current location. Based on the citizen's tip, Leon County Sheriff's Deputies responded to 2060 Continental Avenue, located Bivins and took him into custody without incident. Bivins is a designated Sexual Offender and as such is required to register his current address with the Sheriff's Office in the County in which he resides. Bivins failed to register with the Leon County Sheriff's Office after providing the Florida Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles an address within Leon County. An investigation will be conducted by the LCSO Sex Offender Unit to determine Bivins' recent whereabouts and his current residence.

Sheriff Larry Campbell said "this is a great example of the media getting information out to the public, and citizens assisting law enforcement in locating a wanted sexual offender. This arrest represents the Leon County Sheriff's Office commitment to ensuring that the public is protected from designated Sexual Offenders and Predators who do not register with this Office when they live in Tallahassee/Leon County as required by Florida Statute."
