### LCSO Continues Investigation of Fatal Stabbing

On Saturday morning, October 24, 2009, at 7:40AM Leon County Sheriff's Deputies were called to 9205 Miccosukee Road in reference to a subject who had been stabbed. When Deputies arrived they discovered Timothy J. Cobb, DOB 05/30/1978, inside the residence. CPR was administered by Deputies and Cobb was transported to a local hospital for treatment where he died a short time later. Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Detectives responded to the scene and began an investigation of this death. The preliminary investigation has revealed that Cobb was the former boyfriend of Kathryn Hall, 47yoa, who was inside the residence with Anthony Mack, 40yoa. It has been reported that Cobb was upset that Mack was at the residence and demanded to be let inside. Fearing violence would occur, Hall and Mack refused to allow Cobb inside the residence. Cobb then forced open the locked back door of the residence, entered and attacked Mack. During the violent attack, Mack armed himself with a kitchen knife and stabbed Cobb several times.

On Sunday October 25, 2009, an autopsy was performed on Cobb which confirmed he died as a result of multiple stab wounds. Based on the results of the autopsy, an investigation at the scene and interviews with Hall and Mack, Violent Crimes Detectives are exploring the possibility that Mack acted in self-defense. No criminal charges have been filed; however, when this investigation is completed it will be forwarded to the State Attorney's Office for review.
