Deputies Arrest Student for Burglary of Godby High School

Early this morning, at approximately 1:10AM, Leon County Sheriff's Deputies Sgt. Bobby Green, David Teems and Joe LeSerra responded to Godby High School located at 1717 West Tharpe Street, in reference to alarm activation. While searching the campus, Godby High School Student Bret Pullen was located near the ROTC building. A check of the ROTC building revealed a door was propped open. A small metal safe had been removed from the building and was on the ground near the open door. Pullen admitted opening the door but denied entering the building. Video surveillance of the campus was reviewed and it revealed Pullen walking around on campus in the area of the ROTC building, near where the safe was located. Pullen was arrested and charged with Burglary and Grand Theft.

Two other subjects were located on campus but video surveillance indicated they were not connected with the burglary. However charges may be filed pending further investigation for trespassing on school grounds.
