Argument Leads to Gun Shots and Criminal Charges

On October 26, 2010 at approximately 11:00 am, the Leon County Sheriff's Office responded to 3846 North Monroe Street in reference to a disturbance. Deputies responded to the scene and discovered Michael C. Crockett, 25, in need of medical assistance. Paramedics responded and transported Crockett to Tallahassee Memorial Hospital for injuries received during a physical altercation. Detectives from the Violent Crimes Unit and the Crime Scene Unit responded to conduct witness interviews and collect forensic evidence from the scene.

Detectives learned that the physical altercation took place after Shanda Culp, 24, argued with her ex-boyfriend, Josh Gamble, also 24. The estranged couple argued over a vehicle they had purchased together until the owner of the business became involved and told Culp she had to leave. Crockett, who is Culp's new boyfriend, interjected himself into the argument and pulled a handgun. Other employees who were witnessing the incident fought with Crockett and eventually were able to subdue him and disarm him. During the time that employees were trying to subdue Crockett, he fired several shots with the hand gun. No one was injured by the gunshots; however two of the employees discovered bullet holes in their pants and another found a bullet hole in one of his shoes.

Crockett's was treated and released from the hospital. He was then arrested and taken to the Leon County Jail.
