## Burglary Arrest

**Tallahassee-** Leon County Sheriff's Deputies arrest a subject for armed burglary of an occupied dwelling.

On October 28<sup>th</sup> Deputy Andy Dawson responded to a residence in the 1500 block of Patchwork Trail, in reference to a burglary. The victim told deputies that shortly before midnight, she heard glass breaking and discovered a black male, later identified as Daryl M. Alfred 12-25-63, in her living room beside a broken window. The victim said she called her son, who lives next door, who came over armed with a shotgun and held the suspect at bay until deputies arrived.

Alfred admitted to deputies that he had been using cocaine. He suffered from cuts to his head and hand from the broken glass as he entered the home.

During a search incident to arrest, deputies located a pocket knife on Alfred's person. He was booked into the Leon County Jail charged with Armed Burglary of an Occupied Dwelling. He remains there awaiting first appearance.

Sgt. Reisinger stated that "This is obviously a very traumatic situation that could easily have ended badly for the victim as well as Alfred. Thanks to the actions of all involved no one was hurt during the incident. This should help to remind all of us that even if we are home, where we expect to be insulated from the perils of the outside world, we need to have a plan of action for anything".
